CAMP KADESH Hello Churches,

There is a lot of excitement in our church community as most churches are returning to in-person church services. We are excited that that means there is hope that many things might begin to happen more like before COVID19 disrupted our lives. We continue to hold out hope for overnight camps to happen this summer. In the spirit of hope, here are a few updates from Kadesh. Our AGM will be held via Zoom on April 19, 2021. Delegates from member churches will be emailed a Zoom link directly and AGM package directly. Individuals that are not delegates, but would like to be a part of the meeting can email tim@campkadesh.com for an invitation link and package. The link will not be posted publicly. Things that you can be praying for Camp Kadesh:

- while there is great optimism in communication with the Sask Government, there is yet to be guidelines officially for overnight camp. Pray that God would spur the government to give guidelines for July and August camp planning.
- because of COVID layoffs, Camp Kadesh has lost our Food Services Manager, Property Manager and Director of School Programs to other opportunities. Please pray that we will be able to find the right new full time staff when plans and finances make that possible.
- if and when we are allowed to run we are months behind in the normal process to hire talented young staff. Please pray that the right young staff will still be available when the time comes to begin hiring.

We are hearing from parents often that children need summer camp this year. We are working to be ready when we get the call again. The need for summer camp in our province will be an even greater chance to tell children about Jesus. God is good, and we know His plan will work out.
